#### Recording: how to compose a good frame

- camera angle, positioning, movements
- horizontal image
- adequate spacing
- the rule of thirds



## Recording: lighting

- weather
- natural/artificial light
- pointed on the subject






















#### Recording: audio

- background noises
- microphone close to the <u>subject</u>
- test the audio
- start recording a few seconds earlier and end a few

seconds later

• if you're planning to add a <u>narration voice</u>, synchronize


filming and audio
